



## **CEDAR CLUB OF ATLANTA FOUNDATION- TONY AYOUB FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP**

Dear applicant:

We are pleased that you are applying for the Cedar Club of Atlanta Foundation- Tony Ayoub Family Scholarship!

Scholarship awards are given to high school seniors who are going to be entering freshman in an accredited community college, college, or university, and funds are to be used for educational purposes only. The amount of scholarship money to be awarded will be determined annually by the scholarship committee and will be dependent on funds available and the number and quality of applicants. This year's scholarship is \$1,500.00.

Criteria for this scholarship are as follows:

- 1) You, your parent(s), or your legal guardian must have been a member of one of the 3 main Arabic churches (St. Elias Antiochian Orthodox Church, St. Joseph's Maronite Church, or St. John's Melkite Church) for the 2 years prior to the year in which you apply. (3 years total)
- 2) The priest of one of the above churches must sign the application verifying said membership.
- 3) Applicant must have completed a minimum of 30 community service hours to a charity, local church, or school over the past 4 years
- 4) Applicant must have maintained at least a 3.3 cumulative GPA/85 average (B average).
- 5) Applications must be filled out in full and postmarked by June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 to be considered.
  - a) Applications must include official transcripts through the first semester of the 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Transcripts must be sent in a sealed envelope obtained from the registrar.
  - b) An ACT and/or an SAT score must be included
  - c) Two letters of recommendation must accompany the application, including one letter from either your school counselor or one of your school teachers

**NOTE:** Checks will be mailed directly to the school. It is imperative that you provide the full mailing address and phone number for the appropriate department of the college or university where the scholarship check should be mailed if you were to be awarded the scholarship.

## TONY AND FRANCES AYOUB FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. The Name of this scholarship shall be “Tony and Frances Ayoub Family Scholarship”
2. The purpose of the scholarship shall be to provide recognition and financial assistance to outstanding high school seniors who are members of St. Elias Antiochian Orthodox Church, St. John Melkite Catholic Church, or St. Joseph’s Maronite Catholic Church. The priests of the respective churches will determine if the graduating senior is considered a “church member” or not. The funds are only available to individuals who attend college.
3. The amount shall be \$1,500.00 per scholarship.
4. The funds will be sent directly to the schools on behalf of the recipient (s).
5. Eligibility consideration for this scholarship shall be given to all high school seniors who belong to one of the above 3 churches and who plan to enter college. Criteria will be based on academic performance, test scores, community service, and extracurricular activities. An individual does not have to be a member of the Cedar Club of Atlanta to receive this scholarship.
6. The award is a one time award.
7. Applications will be given to each of the 3 churches in mid March of each year. Applications are to be signed by the priest and then mailed to the Foundation President no later than May 5 to give plenty of time for the applications to be reviewed and ranked. The scholarship(s) will be awarded to the recipients the first week of July.
8. A third party educator, Dr. Mary Jo Lund, who is not a member of the Cedar Club of Atlanta will rank the applicants. This ranking will be reviewed by the Cedar Club Foundation’s Scholarship committee (consisting of Dr. Albert Johary, Charlene Hiffa, & Habib Osta) to determine the final recipient (s) of the scholarship.
